## ATTENDED Funeral (Funeral Directors Charges Only)

**This is a Funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend the Burial or Cremation.**

Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements.	<b>£845.00</b>
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the Funeral Director's premises).	<b>£495.00</b>
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities.	<b>£600.00</b>
Providing a suitable coffin - this will be made from Wood Effect MDF or LifeArt Emissions Board.	<b>£350.00</b>
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment.	<b>£25.00</b>
At a date and time you agree with the Funeral Director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed Cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the Funeral Directors premises, in a Hearse.	<b>£255.00</b>

## FEES YOU MUST PAY

For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the burial fee\*\* **£840.00 - £950.00**

For a new grave you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.

For an Attended cremation funeral the cremation fee\* **£645.00 - £895.00**

\*In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay Doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.

\*\* This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.
